# Who May Benefit from Our Services

Consider patient referral for those who are (or have) the following:



## AGE

- Women over 35 trying for 6 months or more to conceive
- Women under 35 unable to conceive naturally for less than 1 year or more
- Fertility preservation, (egg or embryo preservation)
- Any person, at any age, concerned about a delay in conception



## HEALTH HISTORY

- Known reproductive issues
- Known anatomic/ reproductive issues (Mullerian anomalies, septate uterus, endometrial polyps, submucous myomas)
- PCOS diagnosis or suspected PCOS diagnosis
- Endometriosis diagnosis
- Uterine fibroids
- Diminished ovarian reserve or POI (Primary Ovarian Insufficiency)
- Cancer diagnosis (fertility preservation)
- Thyroid conditions
- Known genetic issues
- Recurrent pregnancy loss
- History of tubal ligation or tubal obstruction
- Concerns with Male Factor Infertility
